

Largo Flying Club General Meeting  
Minutes of July 7, 2015

Meeting called to order at 7 pm by Vice President Wojciechowski in President Gearheart's absence. There were 25 members present.

1. Minutes of the June 2, 2015 meeting were read and approved. Motion to accept by Tim Wojciechowski, seconded by Ed Rouisse. Motion carried.

2. Reports from officers:

f. Newsletter editor Russ Cromwell thanked members for their articles for the newsletter.
